

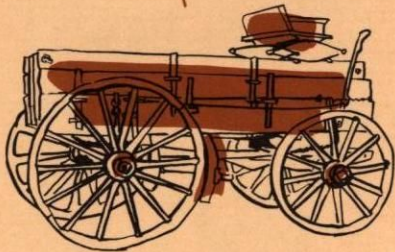

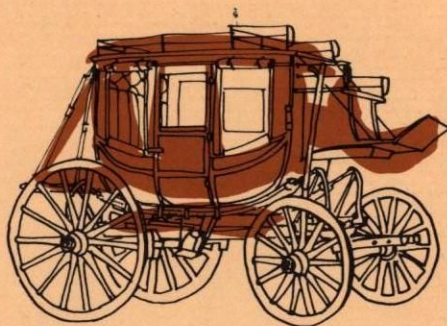

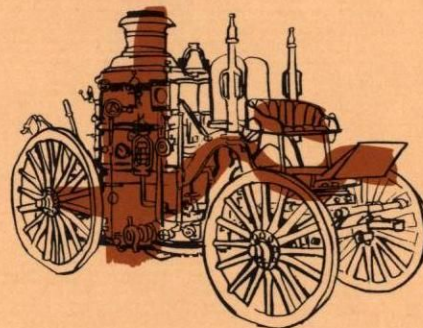
# THE GANNON MUSEUM OF WAGONS



Here can be seen not only the stagecoach, Conestoga, and other relics of overland travel but also many fine carriages, masterpieces of Yankee craftsmanship. Municipal, farm, fire, and business wagons, too, stand in grand array, proud phantoms from the past. A revelation for youngsters, a pleasure for oldsters, the Gannon Museum represents a new direction for modern museums and galleries.



In an air-conditioned fireproof building at the west edge of Mabton is repositied the West's most comprehensive collection of vehicles, accessories, and documents pertaining to the day of the coach and wagon maker. Open May through August; closed Mondays. Open at other times by appointment.

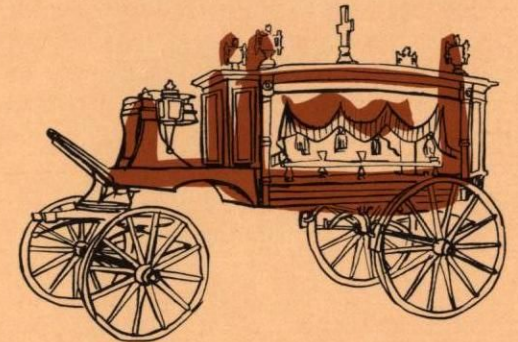

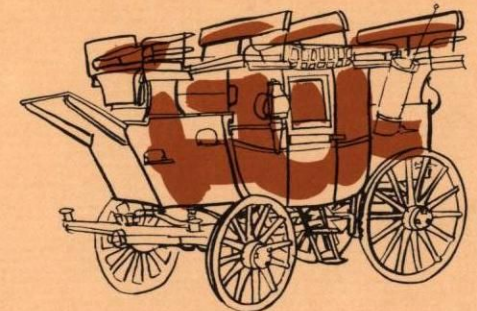
The entire family will find pleasure and discovery in this exhibition of treasures from the repertory of history.

Old prints, photos, and posters hang beside wagon jacks, carriage robes, hame bells, and hundreds of other horse-age keepsakes. The library, which contains a large selection of journals, cards, and catalogs from the carriage industry, is available to serious hobbyists and historians.
