Tappanish^{volunteer} - Had no meeting - have talked matter
irregularly - Don't know prevailing opinion

Louis Guertels^{volunteer} - Thinks majority of Dist op-
posed -

Leanyon Dist

Leawasha - Had meeting - of Dist - decided
in favor of admitting st. 10 per mo -

John Dick - Majority think best to admit stock
very few opposed - at first opposed on ground
that Encas & Shun got benefit - Mannick^{of} knew
nothing of matter. After understanding matter ~~in~~ favor
pastorage -

(Agent Explained that all money ^{is} paid to him, and
sent to Washington, - and, ^{he} recommends the manner
of expenditure - No one else ^{knows} or has to
do with money - no blame to any other but
me - If I don't do right blame me, no
one else - Never again blame Eneas, Joe
Sturte or any one else)
