

SCULPSTONE is a versatile mineral, soft enough to be easily carved with a knife, yet hard enough to be made into permanent objects of rare beauty.

It is an ancient carving craft nearly forgotten for centuries. Sculpstone is acclaimed with great enthusiasm by artists, hobbyists and all craftsmen. It has the beauty of marble, the workability approaching that of wood and surpasses jade in the variety of colors. Hobbyists and professionals are thrilled with its beautiful grain and texture.

No special tools are needed. Handsome pieces can be made with a pocket knife. Sculpstone can be filed, drilled, planed, sandpapered, smoothed and polished with fine steel wool; it can be turned on a lathe and is also easily carved with power tools. You can polish with oil or wax. This brings out the beautiful grain in the stone while aiding its preservation. It can be attained with any colors; glazed and fired by the same process used in ceramics.

Sculpstone is impervious to action by ordinary chemicals, to corrosion by air or water or to the application of heat.

Sculpstone is mined in the Far East and other sections of the world. Color ranges from white to black, pink to red, blue to green of rare subtle béauty.

No two pieces of Sculpstone are alike and many are translucent. We hope that this pamphlet will aid those who wish to work in this amazing medium. You will discover many things about this "wonder" stone. Think clearly, proceed with care and always plan your project a bit larger than the preliminary sketch. This allows for some minor mistakes especially for beginners. You can also make castings from this stone.

# HISTORY

Oldest records of Sculpstone as a carving medium is found in Sanscrit and in Holy Hindu books. In parts of India it is called image stone which indicates its use for carvings for worship. Centuries ago the clever Chinese were the first to discover its beauty and workability. Their figurines of Sculpstone are still prized as objects d'art, having withstood centuries of use. Egyptian excavations have revealed beautiful carvings in the form of jewelry, scarabs, etc., made from this amazing permanent stone. It was through the search for the stone of Magi that Theophrastus Paracelsus, the alchemist, discovered its fine sculpturing qualities and artists quickly adopted Sculpstone to express their talents. In the cathedral of Trondheim, Norway, ornaments and figurines were found carved from this medium.

## OCCUPATIONAL THERAPISTS



# S C U L P S T O N E CAN BE TURNED ON ANY LATHE!

Beautiful, decorative pieces like vases, candleholders, chessmen, ash trays, etc., can be turned easier than wood for home, profit or gifts. Do not apply too much pressure when fastening. Insert stone in wood block on chuck end to ease pressure. In general use low speed on large pieces and fast speeds for small pieces.

## FINISHING

- 1. Sand and steel wool if smooth surface is desired. When oil is applied the natural color of the stone is revealed (Sculpstone oil is highly effective). Allow about ten minutes to dry. Polish surface with soft cloth or buffer. Oil again and repeat until desired finish is attained.
- 2. For surface protection apply Sculpstone hardener with brush or spray. Allow to set ten minutes for small pieces, 25 minutes for large pieces. For higher gloss, polish as above.
