WHEREAS, citizens of Chinook, Washington will always be welcome to visit their sister city of Saint Louis, Missouri:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Alfonso J. Cervantes, Mayor of the City of Saint Louis, Missouri, do hereby proclaim the week of January 31 to February 6, 1966, as

"CHINOOK, WASHINGTON WEEK"

in Saint Louis and call upon all citizens to express appropriate observance of this occasion.
