these were cognate people with those involved in my study, this
material, and the manner of its presentation, is thought provoking and
helpful.

Enclosed: Associated Press dispatch of Sept. 22, 1954, relative to
Tommy Thompson of the Wyampum Indians at Celilo. His attitude in view
of this, relative to the Yakima claims for damages due to loss of Celilo
fishery remain to be seen. Moreover it generally seems to a layman that
if Tommy T. must wait to bring suit, such might be the course of the
Yakimas, in event no settlement is reached regarding the Celilo fishery.
