NATIONAL CONGRESS OF AMERICAN INDIANS

NCAI WORKS FOR: legislation approved by Indians—federal policy that recognizes and protects Indian rights—programs (both government and private) that are approved by Indians—and unity among Indians in promoting their common interests.

NCAI OPPOSES: legislation harmful to Indians—discrimination against Indians—exploitation of Indian resources—attacks on Indian rights.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Voting membership in NCAI is limited to Indian tribes and individuals, according to the following annual dues schedule (adopted at the 1953 Convention):

- a. Individuals — \$3.00 each
- b. Tribes or groups numbering 1 to 2500: \$25.00 plus 5c per member
Tribes numbering 2,500 to 25,000: \$125.00 plus 1½c per member
Tribes numbering more than 25,000: \$250.00 plus ½c per member.
- c. Chapters — \$25.00

(Non-voting, associate membership for non-Indian individuals, and annual subscription to NCAI publications is \$10.00 minimum.)
