I wish to re-type one page of the "treatise" about the Wanapums prepared for Mr. Ramsey. The original, with photographs and maps etc. was turned over to you here at Yakima. There are no maps or additions with the copy.

I shall send it to you shortly and you may turn it over to the proper person.

In connection with this hurriedly prepared material, mainly important for its citations as to references and repositories, I mention that I had no specific knowledge as to the type of report. It was done to show occupancy and use, plus moral rights, of the Wanapums. And, it may sound, like me, a "reluctant" witness. But perhaps there is solace in knowing material that the opposite side may have stumbled upon.

Now that I have a clearer understanding, and have observed the reaction of various Indians concerned, I feel more competent to get into the actual situation more rapidly. That should enable you, and your professional aides in their various fields, to obtain a good picture of the situation from this end and couple it with the benefit of professional service from the other.
