

STREAM BANK ACCESS COMMITTEE REPORT

December 9, 1962

The chairman read emergency resolution #1 sponsored by this committee. Norm Knott, Game Department, explained the resolution saying it was simply applying the Angle Lake doctrine to all lakes and streams. John Evensen spoke on the importance of the resolution. This is the kind of legislation this committee has worked towards for the past ten years.

In Section 2, first sentence words "every lake and stream" were amended to read "all lakes and streams!".

This committee voted to support emergency resolution no. 1. The vote was unanimous.

Resolution #14 was considered. It was pointed out that people are currently parking along limited access highways and the necessity of this resolution was questioned. Norm Knott reported when limited access highways are completed and fenced, parking is prohibited. Plans for the Easton - Cle Elum highway call for the reduction of available parking areas from six to one. Al Pritchard stressed the national magnitude of access problems along interstate highways. This committee voted to support this resolution.

Forty-six members and delegates were present.
