This will acknowledge receipt of my copy of the signed contract pertaining to Drummers and Dreamers.

It will also serve as a notation for your records that I have agreed to purchase for my own purposes \$300 (three hundred) deliars worth of the book.

I pleced the figure at \$200 to \$300 worth, but the way things are shaping up. I see use for the latter amount. And I give a figure on the pumber in view of the price noted in the contract, more or less that does not permit se to errive at an actual figure, in numbers, as yet.
