

- 1880 First Church was organized on October 16 in Union Gap with twelve members. The Sunday School was organized October 17.
- 1882 The first church building was dedicated on January 1 in Yakima City, or Union Gap.
- 1885 The church and building were moved to North Yakima to a site between Yakima Avenue and "A" Street on the east side of Third Street.
- 1890 The women were organized as the Christian Women's Board of Missions and the Senior Christian Endeavor came into being.
- 1907 The new church was built on the new site, Third and "B" Streets.
- 1909 The church was dedicated with Charles Reign Scoville as guest speaker.
- 1910 Henry Bicknell gave \$3,000 for the first pipe organ.
- 1923 Dr. Douglas S. Corpron became our first Living Link Missionary. With his family he went to China where they served twenty-five years.
- 1927 Our educational building was dedicated.
- 1943 Land was leased on the Naches River where our \$35,000 church camp was constructed.
- 1949 The ground at Fifth Avenue and Prasch was purchased for the new Broadway Church and dedicated.
- 1950 The Broadway Church was dedicated.
- 1953 April 16 site of the branch church at Englewood and 44th purchased.
- 1955 First Church votes to establish branch at Westpark site.
- 1956 January 8. Branch Sunday School began in Westpark Kindergarten.
