SPECIAL SURVEY YAKIMA CITY POLICE March, April and May 1947

There were four hundred and forty-four urban accidents during March, April and May 1947. (March, 139 accidents, April, 143 accidents, and May, 162 accidents.) There were no fatal accidents, thirty-four personal injury accidents and four hundred and ten property damage accidents. The ratio 0-34-410. The Yakima City Police Department ratio for investigated accidents is 0-16-62, which indicates that 17.6% of the total urban accidents were investigated. 47% of the personal injury accidents and 15% of the property damage accidents were investigated by the Yakima City Police Department.

THE ECONOMIC LOSS IN THE CITY OF YAKIMA ATTRIBUTED TO REPORTED URBAN MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS DURING THIS PERIOD WAS \$66,975.00.

86.4% of the drivers involved in urban accidents in the City of Yakima lived within 15 miles of the accident scene.

The elements of selective enforcement reveal that the City of Yakima has 20% of the reported accidents occurring during a two hour period from 4:00 p. m. to 6:00 p. m., with the predominant violation being Failure to yield right of Way at Intersection contributing to 26% of the reported urban accidents. 21.4% of the accidents for this three month period occurred on Saturday followed by Tuesday and Thursday, each accounting for 15.3% of the urban accidents. Sunday was low day in the week with 9.7% of the accidents for this period.

AS A RESULT OF THE 444 REPORTED URBAN ACCIDENTS 557 VIOLATIONS WERE RECORDED WHICH IS 1.25 VIOLATIONS PER ACCIDENT.

During this three month period, nine pedestrians were injured in the City of Yakima. 44% of the pedestrians ages were omitted from the accident report. The remaining 56% of the pedestrians ages were found in the following age groups: 5 - 9 years old - 2 pedestrians; 45 - 64 years old - 1 pedestrian; and 65 years old and over - 2 pedestrians. Four pedestrians were injured while crossing at intersections with signal. 1 pedestrian was injured while crossing at intersection against the traffic signal. Three pedestrians were injured crossing street not at intersection and coming from behind parked cars accounted for 1 pedestrian injured.

Bicyclists accounted for 6 personal injury accidents in the City of Yakima during this period. The 10 - 14 year old age group accounted for four bicyclists injured, while in the 5 - 9 year old age group we find only 1 bicyclists involved in an accident. The remaining one bicyclist was in the 45 - 64 year old age group. Two bicyclists were injured while crossing at intersection with signals. One was injured crossing not at intersection. Riding in the roadway with traffic accounted for two bicycle accidents, while riding in roadway against traffic accounted for only one bicycle accident.





13.2% of the drivers involved in accidents in the City of Yakima failed to state their age. This could be remedied by checking each accident report as the responsible agency receives it. The 18 year old age group was involved in 3.3% of the accidents, followed by the 20 year old age group which accounted for 3.2% of the accidents.



91% of the accidents in the City of Yakima involved two or more motor vehicles. Of these accidents, 16.9% occurred at intersection - both entering - going straight. 5.6% of these accidents occurred while one car was properly parked - other from same direction.
