# Application and Registration Procedures

1. Students presently attending YVC:

Complete the pre-registration form provided in the Registrar's Office. Complete registration on June 19 or 20 in the Registrar's Office. All fees must be paid at the time of registration.

### 2. College transfer students:

- a. Secure an application form from your college or from YVC. Page 1 of this form should be completed and sent to the Registrar's Office, YVC. If you have never attended YVC, your \$5.00 non-refundable application processing fee should accompany the application.
- b. Send a complete transcript of your college work to the Registrar's Office, YVC. A spring quarter grade report, in lieu of a complete transcript, is acceptable for the purpose of summer college registration.
- c. Complete registration on June 19 or 20 in the Registrar's Office. All fees must be paid at the time of registration.
- d. It is stressed that acceptance of a transfer student for the summer quarter does not indicate acceptance for the regular college academic year.

### 3. High school graduates:

a. Secure an application form from your high school or from YVC. Page 1 of this form should be completed and sent to the Registrar's Office, YVC. The \$5.00 non-refundable application processing fee should accompany the application.

- b. Take pages 2 and 3 of the application to your high school and request that they fill in the information and send a complete high school transcript to YVC.
- c. Send a copy of your Washington Pre-College test to YVC.
- d. Complete registration on June 19 or 20 in the Registrar's Office. All fees must be paid at the time of registration.
- 4. Terminal students not involved in a degree program:
  - a. The terminal student may register in the evening (7:15-9:15) of June 18, 19, 23, or 24.

### **FEES**

All fees are payable at the time of registration.
