We are looking forward to hearing you tell us of Fort Simcoe and hope you find us an appreciative audience.

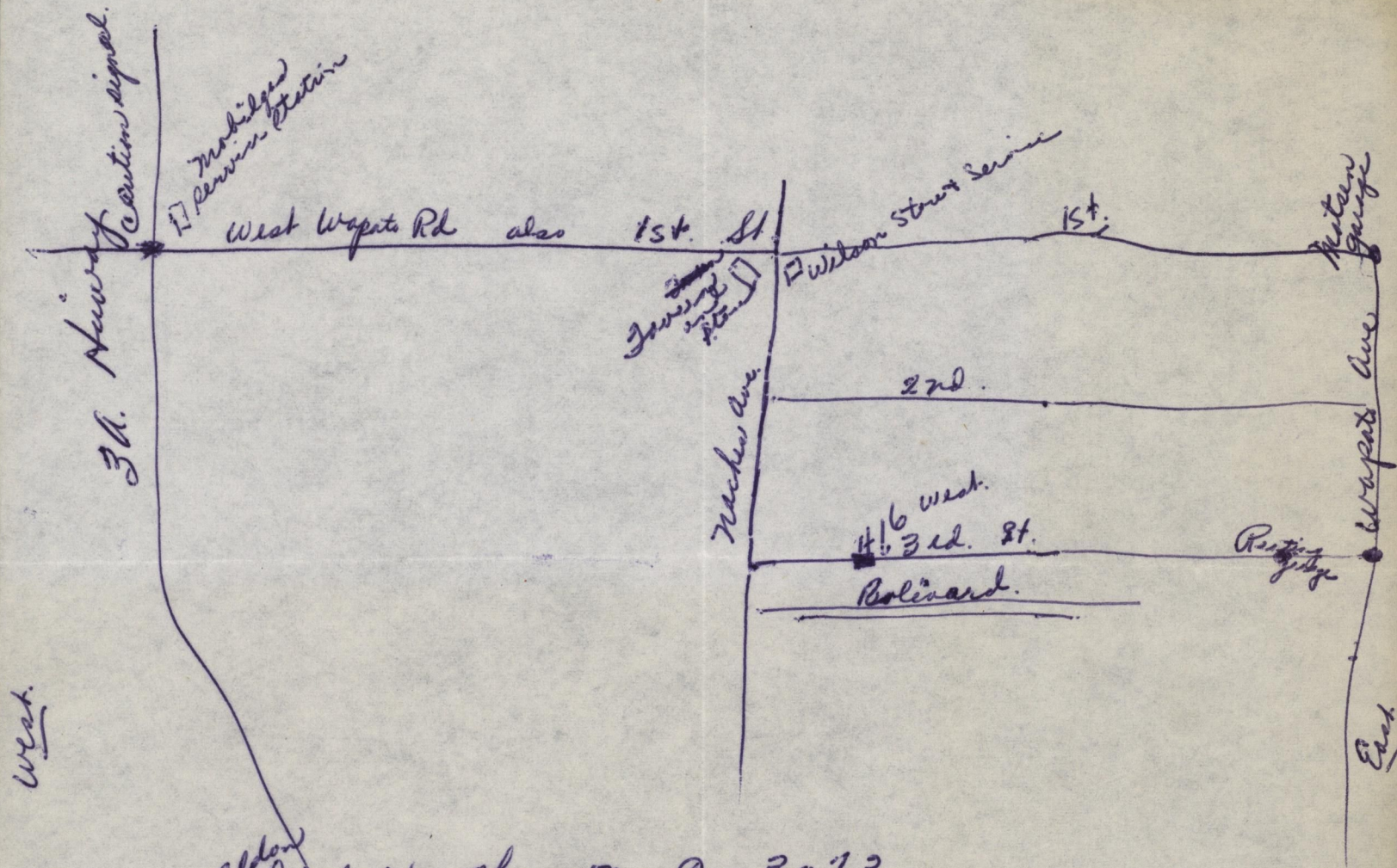
The meeting is to be at the Eldon Dietrich home, 416 West 3rd.
