If you come to town and drop out to see me, you will find me at the house closest to the highway, now. I have the same phone number. Moving over to the new place has been one of the things that kept me busy. I have a big library in the basement and that took lots of work.

I have received copies of material from the biologist and from the Indian Mission. I am sure it will add much to my knowledge of the situation when I sit down and read it thoroughly.
