that marks entrances to more than 2,500 Federal recreation fee areas where carload recreation fees are charged.

HELP INCREASE OUTDOOR RECREATION OPPORTUNITIES

All entrance and user fees collected at Federal recreation areas go to the Land and Water Conservation Fund to provide more national, State, and local outdoor recreation opportunities.

- * The Golden Eagle Passport also will admit the purchaser *alone* to designated walk-in Federal fee areas. It does *not* cover special user or service charges.
