Just 50 years ago on the night of May 12, 1895, a group of 27 men joined in the bonds of the Order under a charter founding Yakima Lodge Number 318 of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks.

The first Exalted Ruler, John B. Catron, and his fellow officers were installed by members from the Tacoma Lodge. Catron was a former member of the Tacoma Elks.

Of the original 27 charter members only three are now living: I. H. "Harry" Dills, H. H. Lombard, and A. L. Dilley. All three are now active members of Yakima Lodge.

Down through this past half-century the Elks in Yakima have experienced good times and bad, but the progress has always been based upon sound planning for a steady and healthy growth. Today the Yakima Elks own their beautiful Temple and have bonds in the bank for future contingencies. A membership of over one thousand Brothers enjoy the privileges of the modern clubrooms.

It is the purpose of this booklet to depict your 1945 Yakima Elks Lodge as the 50-year mark is passed . . . to recall familiar scenes and faces.


The annual Christmas party for underprivileged children has been a tradition with Yakima Lodge since the time of George Vance who was Exalted Ruler in 1904-1905.

Brother Vance originally gave Christmas dinners to the local newsboys. After about three years he sold the idea to Yakima Lodge as a Lodge activity. The idea caught on and today this tradition is still maintained although now any needy child in the city of Yakima may attend.

The original dinner idea has been enlarged. Children not only get their "turkey n' trimmings" but also are given packages of goodies and clothing where needed. Special moving pictures and floor shows are provided between courses of the dinner.



In April, 1942, your Lodge unanimously voted to sponsor and finance a permanent "blood bank" for this area. Dr. E. S. West, one of the instigators of the idea was made chairman. The Elks own blood helped fill the "bank" after their dollars financed it.



Way back in 1925 Yakima Lodge sponsored the organization of Boy Scout troop No. 18. It is significant that this year, 1945, completes twenty years of sponsoring of this troop.
