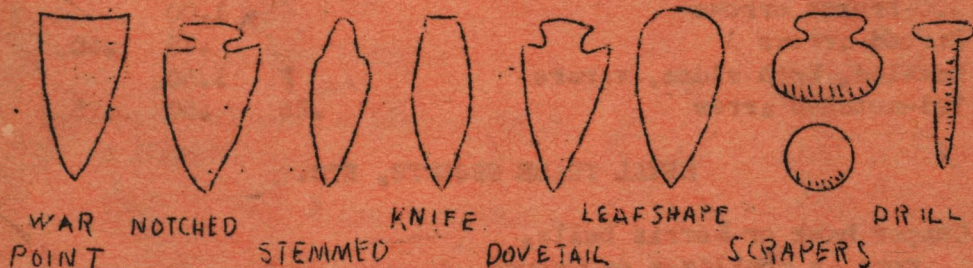


# AMERICAN INDIAN RELICS

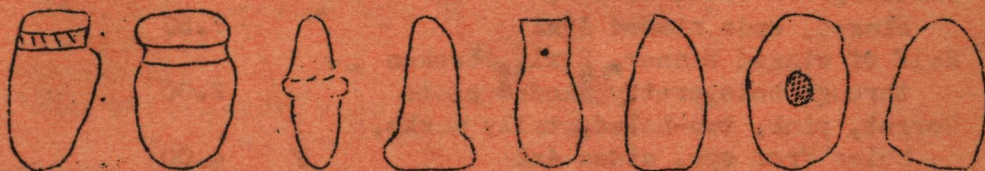
