The Co owns 360 acres of deeded
mineral land and have an addit-
ional 200 acres of mineral and timber
claims under location and develop-
ment rights. The ore yields gold
silver ~~and~~ lead and copper, ~~in the~~
values in the order named.

2. The shaft is 250' deep with 1000' of drifts and tunnels on three levels.

The present blocked ore body amounts to 63,000 tons valued at ^{\$}13 per ton.

The average width of vein on the 250' level is 16'; on the 150' level the vein is 14' and continues this average to the surface. The vein ~~system~~ ^{is} true with well defined foot and hanging walls. Pockets of high grade ore appear in the vein system increasing the per ton value of the ore.

V. Pres. V. S. Radmacher ~~of Tipton~~ says the present plans of the Co are to straighten the tunnels, install new track and water pumps and raise a new two compartment shaft from the 250' level. A modern ventilating system will be installed at this time. The latest type of ore breaking, milling equipment is on order and the most efficient method of recovering the values are being studied.

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3 Our buildings are adequate for the present and consist of power house and hoist room, office bldg ^{for} ~~four~~ bunk ~~houses~~ furnished with accommodations for 16 men, and a large Cook house. A saw-mill has been installed with ample capacity for any future development. The property is ~~five~~ miles from U.S. Highway 395 and the G.N. R.R. and Kettle River.
