per my contract. I telegraphed you
a week ago for information as to point
you wanted goods shipped but have
had no reply, but I am doing right

Since writing other side I have received
your telegram and have changed
arrangement to The Dalles. I have
also received telegram from Asst Genl
Freight Agent N P R R saying box
will be laid to Prosser Station Oct 15th 1894

15th of October. I can hold your
goods here if you wish and will
do so if you will so advise me
by telegraph. Your goods from
New York have been all been shipped
to Kinney's Station via Astoria. I
guess they will have to lay at Astoria
until road is open. I can't stand
it to pay local charges from
Astoria to The Dalles and then
take pay on my Dalles contract.
If you are in a hurry for the
goods I will have them sent to The
Dalles but I shall expect you to
receive for them at Prosser Station.
