Dear Mr. Relander:

Thank you for your kind letter of February 22. We will be glad to make a rubber mold on a life size head of which you sent a photograph, but the problem is going to be to get the head here if it is in clay. From a practical point of view, this is impossible. I think it would be better if you made the rubber mold yourself. You would have to insert mold dividing brass to form a web between the fingers and between the chin and neck and then insert more dividing brass from the bottom of the base up to the top of the head so that the mold would open up in the back in the form of a coat.

If you follow the instructions in the Pliatex Instruction folder enclosed, I am sure you will have success. Please remember to give the mold two coats of shellac before applying the rubber.

If you succeed in making a plaster cast, we could galvano-bronze the cast. It would cost about \$35 or \$40 provided the plaster cast is white and has not been shellacked or otherwise treated. We do not have any samples of Galvano to send, I am sorry to say. This is strictly custom service and samples would be too expensive to turn out.

If you would like the head cast in bronze an approximate price is \$135.

If you order several copies to be galvano bronzed, the price would be only a little bit reduced from the cost of the first copy. A life-size head generally costs about \$110. in bronze.
