The Oregon Archaeological Society was formed early in 1951 for the purpose of preserving the archaeological and historical material of the Oregon country by cooperating with scientific and academic organizations in their archaeological work, and by stimulating public interest in the romance and science of the studies of local ancient man. Regular monthly meetings are held and a bulletin, "SCREENINGS", is sent each month to members.

Few areas in the United States are as rich in archaeology as the Columbia River and adjacent areas. Since many rich sites are now disappearing under backwaters of dams and from other commercial enterprises, we feel that a great need exists to salvage all available material and knowledge, to locate and map the ancient village sites, and to dispense the results to the public. We also believe that by protecting sites from indiscriminate digging, we can conserve many of these vanishing pages of history for future generations, whose scientific technique may be vastly superior to ours.

We look upon our hobby as worthy of serious study and are anxious to learn more of the methods, aims and results of the science, and to pass on that which we have learned to each other, to the interested public, and to the professional student. (Con't on last page)

That which we find may be ours, but it was abstracted from one of our great, non-replaceable natural resources and the people have a legitimate right to enjoy it as we do.

We feel that we cannot prosper as a Society without the friendship of the professional archaeologist, and therefore cooperate in word and deed with those who devote their lives to the science and believe that both will benefit thereby.
