TOP-NISH- means sloping ground . Word from which Topenish derived its name. Name for creek as well as city. Specifically Top-Nish was the camp ground and ~~meeting~~ council place at present site of White Swan Long House, south of White Swan.

TOPPENISH-A ~~town~~ city, creek and mountain ridge ~~needed needed needed~~
in central Yakima County taking its name from the word Top-nish,
and Thap Pahn Ish
also spelled Thapnish, Sahpenis, ~~and~~ Qapuish, meaning specifically
sloping down from the contour of the ~~xxx~~ country. It was the site of
an old council grounds, south of White Swan where the present White Swan
long house is located.

A petition was circulated in November, 1889 asking that ~~the~~
a post office be established at Toppenish. Mrs. N.H. Lillie built the
first store there in 1887, it burned a year later and she constructed ~~a~~
another for a store but it was used as a schoolhouse. George Harvey of
Zillah built a store there about that time and sold it to J.B. George.
The town was incorporated by election April 19, 1907 and the first
Commercial Club, which became the Chamber of Commerce, was established
in March, 1909 and incorporated for the purpose of "disseminating
knowledge, to do publicity work in behalf of Toppenish and the
neighboring county and to meet as a social club, have a ~~xx~~ library,
readingroom, etc.
