

## A PIONEER'S SEARCH FOR AN IDEAL HOME

A PIONEER'S SEARCH FOR AN IDEAL HOME was originally published in a very limited edition by the author in 1925. It soon became a regional classic and a sought-after collector's item. Because of its historical authenticity, beauty of expression, and increasing rarity, the Washington State Historical Society decided to republish the book.

In his preface John M. McClelland, Jr. who has edited and written a foreword to the new edition, says: "this account of pioneer life is no ordinary reminiscence, nor is it a diary . . . day by day chronologies lack the stirring sweep of an adventure related in narrative form after it has been experienced." Though in her 80's when she wrote it, Mrs. Judson's story was remarkably clear and accurate, so keen was her memory. She "makes the scenes (of pioneer life) come vividly alive".

This new edition of A PIONEER'S SEARCH FOR AN IDEAL HOME, by Phoebe Goodell Judson, edited and with a new foreword by John M. McClelland, Jr., also contains new illustrations, footnotes and a map of Washington Territory during the period of Mrs. Judson's narrative.
