'Popular' Library To Be New Feature

The popular library is a new feature of the Yakima Valley Regional Library's new home. The area, located on the main floor at the southeast corner of the library, contains a collection of books expected to have a high degree of interest.

Comfortable furniture has been included in the browsing area of the popular library for persons

wishing to examine books on the shelves there. The books are not on reserve and may be checked out just as are the books on the general circulation shelves. In fact, this is where the popular books are selected.

There are 12 reader interest groups into which the books here are divided. Included are fiction,

non-fiction, sports, hobbies and current events.

Approximately 2,500 books are on the shelves in this area while another 2,500 books are available to replace them while they are checked out. The popular library in this way brings the library's most used books together into one area for patron's convenience.
