To His Excellency Governor Neil.

Some of the Indians that are here belonging to Capt. Jims. wished me to write to you to find out what you wanted them to do, as they could not find out by Capt. Jims. They are anxious to stay here.

I have conversed with most of the settlers here, and it is the wish of all, that they should be removed to the Reservation and made to stay there.

They say that they got no rations at the Duck Valley Reservation and they say they will not go back there. We have been driven from our homes twice on

account of Indians, and if these Indians are allowed to stay here and roam where they like, the same thing will occur again in less than two years. These Indians claim to be Putes, and say they do not belong to the Duck Valley Reservation as that belongs to the Shoshones, if this is the case they should be provided for at some other place.
