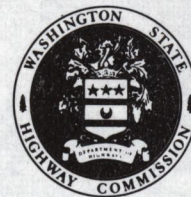

### SUMMER FERRY SCHEDULE Effective June 16

The State Ferry System's summer schedule will go into effect at 12:01 a.m. Sunday, June 16. All routes are affected with changes including different departure times, additional trips, and longer days of operation.

The Seattle-Winslow and Seattle-Bremerton routes reflect a number of revisions with the assignment of all four new super-ferries. The Seattle-Bremerton route will have hour-on-the-hour ferry service from Seattle and the Navy Yard city throughout most of the day and night. On the Seattle-Winslow route trips are approximately every 40 minutes from both sides with service provided on a 24-hour basis on that busy route.

Other routes reflect considerably more scheduled service than has ever been provided in previous summers. The summer schedule will initiate 40-minute service on the Point Defiance-Tahlequah route, made necessary by increasing volume on that route. A number of changes are being made on the Fauntleroy-Vashon-Southworth route to provide improved service between Fauntleroy and Vashon, especially during peak commuter periods.

Increased trips and greater regularity are planned for the Edmonds-Kingston and Mukilteo-Columbia Beach routes with extra service provided on weekends as needed.

Three international trips daily between Anacortes and Sidney, B. C. are being offered this summer. There will be 11 trips between Anacortes and the San Juan Islands this year.

The new summer schedule also shows new ferry rates which go into effect on Sunday, June 16.

Schedules are available throughout the Puget Sound area at terminals of Washington State Ferries.
