I send you a letter for Shuster, he says he wants you to have that man Eby to leave there. He turns his horses on his wheat and takes the Salmon out of his trap and bothers his chickens and takes all the eggs and there is many other complaints he always goes after him. I wrote to Eby the other day, and Shuster says he turns them in after dark. ---

We are very near half alone the rain will put us back a day or two, will start the mowers this afternoon. I have just got back from the Piney Ranch. Brother ~~and~~ Bowd sent me word this morning to drive in 2 Buck he told me they were at the Steam Mill and

would be down soon - if there ever any
one coming down the last of this week
I would like one half Rake as we want to get
done as soon as possible. I have plenty of
men now how long they will last
I can't say ..

lumber for work in bay harry & myself
go to speak to Brother Marechel before
you leave
