got back from the Pinto Ranch. Brother

to drive in 2 Beef he told me they
were at the Steam Mill and

would be now soon - if there was any
one coming about the last of this week
would like one hagg. Kate as we want to get
done as soon as possible. I have plenty of
men now how long they will last
I cant say.

fore you leave
