She proposes to remain
about 7 weeks giving time
to visit Berlin, Prague Dres-
den - Vienna and Nuremberg
sailing homeward Oct 13.

She would in that case, now
stop in Switzerland with Mrs
L. for 2 or 3 weeks to rest, &
visit Paris with my family on
my return from Germany.

The entire cost of this additional
tour for the 7 weeks will be
\$300.

You will permit me
to add that Miss Blanche has so
endeared herself to our family that
she will be a most welcome guest
with us in Switzerland & in Paris
whilst not en route. And

that if it is consonant with
your wishes she could hardly
make a more advantageous
use of that amount of
time and cost.

She is hoping this may
reach you in time to permit
you to cable me at Geneva
Aug 18. of your wish, in order
that if it meets your approval
she may then return to Lucerne
with Mrs L.

Should this fail to reach
you in time please then
cable me at Paris.
