Being a lover of horses and a keen observer of their actions in various situations, he carries a sketch book along on his trips to make sketches when possible. When the action is too fast or the weather too rugged, he paints his impressions from memory when he returns to the studio. In order to put the atmosphere and feeling into a painting, the artist must experience the situations he paints and transmit them in an understandable and interesting way to those who view the painting.

Quigley's paintings hang in many homes in the west and are not confined to framed paintings. There are large murals in private homes and public buildings, several as large as thirty by eight feet. His wood-carvings ornament, as part of the architecture, several fine homes in Oregon and California. He has an interesting array of small art objects carved in various woods which will be on exhibition with his paintings at the Maryhill Museum of Fine Arts in June and July.

Quigley studied at the Art Institute and the Academy of Fine Arts in Chicago. He spent ten years doing commercial art work in Chicago, then returned to Portland to continue in commercial art. For several years he has been doing what he always wanted to do—paint horses.
