I have the honor
to Submit my Report for the month of June 1877.
Quite the fore part of the month was spent
with Col. Watkins, Capt Wilkerson & Gen
Howard. Col Watkins, after carefully
examining the Papers of the Office in company
with myself and the above named gentlemen
visited different parts of the Reservation.

The drumming, drumming Bands of Indians
belong properly to this Agency, and those
belonging to other Agencies around us of the
same Character, were gathered in council and
agreed to go to their respective Agencies and live.

One week was spent going to, at, and returning
from Dallas City Oregon. During the month I have
visited the bands of Indians above named, to know if
they had any sympathy with the fighting band in Idaho.
The Indians of the Agency and the bands referred to were
were more at rest & satisfied than now. Yours truly
