Sir

Enclosed please find permit to pasture your sheep on this Reservation. I had forgotten the number you mentioned, but thought two thousand would cover it. However, that will be all right.

I have not defined the location very closely - in fact could not, without more information. Your letter says, "between the head of Pine Creek, and the Goldendale road", but does not state which Goldendale road - whether from Yakima, or from some other point. I presume however that will be all right. Instructions have been given to the man in charge of the Government Cattle at Topnish bridge, to look after those fellows who are pasturing sheep on the Reservation without authority.
