Dear Mr. Morton:

In compliance with letter of January 8, 1954, enclosed is statement of dates and trips for research in connection with preparation of Yakima MS-I, sent to The Department, December 12, 1953.

Trip to Toppenish Indian Agency, Nov. 19, 1953, 44 miles, one hour research.

Trip to Toppenish Indian Agency, Nov. 23, 1953, 44 miles, one and one-half hours research.

Trip to Toppenish Indian Agency, Nov. 24, 1953, 44 miles, two hours research.

Interview with Indian informants (2) pertaining to preparation of Yakima MS-I, during trip to White Swan, Nov. 28, 1953, wherein mileage was personal matter because of Fort Simcoe inspection, made same date, one and one-half hours.

Research while at Toppenish Agency, Dec. 1, 1953 1 hour, after other research was completed.

Research while at Toppenish Agency, Dec. 4 (no mileage expense) two hours.

Research at Toppenish Agency, Dec. 5, after other research was completed one-half hour.

Preparation, December 10, 1953, three and one-half hours.

Preparation, December 11, three hours

[All other research and notes on hand and previously prepared in files]

Total mileage 132 miles  
Total hours 16

In reference to RAB:LLY 90-2-20-222, January 9, 1954, paragraph III "...the number of hours and mileage incurred in this assignment should be included in your statement for the month of December 1953..."

There is no mileage and no time involved since this was taken care of on a personal research trip to the Toppenish Agency, the letters were readily located and the cooperation of the superintendent in charge was graciously extended.
