Kespelem Feb 4th, 1889

Chos to wiah Chief of the Yakimas.
Dear Sir

Please tell the Indians
at Simcoe that I think they did
wrong in gathering all of the ^(wallose stock) stock
and giving them to Mrs Wallose
for you all know she lived only
a short time with Wallose,
she never bore him any children
you know she lived a short time
with one man and then a short time
with other men and then a short
time with Wallose and finally
handed this young man Wallose gun
and got him to kill Wallose with
it- And you know she is a
prostitute and only lived with
Old Wallose that she might
kill him and get his property-

and I think the Property should be
taken from her and given to Walter
relations If she had been a good
woman If she had been married to
Walter or had lived with him long or
borne him Children I would not say
this but as it is we feel very bad
about it and do not want to see her
have all that property I do not feel
bad about this for myself but it is for
my friends that I speak to you
Your Friend Chief Moses x his mark
