Books Dealing With World Crisis Added To the List

Mrs. Margaret Burgner, president of the Selah Public Library board, has received from the Carnegie Endowment, four new books, dealing with present world conditions. These are in addition to the numerous volumes previously received from the endowment.

"Paddy, the Cope" is an Irish story, setting forth the incredible conditions under which the Irish of the past generation grew up. It is an inspiring story of the development of the co-operative movement in a remote part of Ireland.

"Our India" by Minoo Masani deals with the problems of India and the hope of her people for better living and growth.

"Toward Freedom" by Jawharlal Nehru, the great Indian leader. It is a masterpiece of literature and is a fair presentation of the case for India.

"America in World Affairs" by Allan Nevins. It is concerned chiefly with events following the first World War and leading up to the present.
