We deny and protest all reports that have been published through the press and our community stands ready to work with the government in any way that is asked to make the conditions ideal for the location of the Agency here.

The Indians have been led to believe the funds would come from Tribal funds and also to complain of other matters which are on a par if not better than elsewhere we petition your Honor for personal consideration in order that the work may proceed and the Agency placed in the most practical place where your matters may be best handled.
