Just checked with Archives regarding Agent Wilbur's reports for 1874-79. They are in the printed reports of the Department of the Interior for those years. They are age about two pages in length. The books are available in most libraries so it might be easier to borrow them and copy the reports than to microfilm them.

The original copies along with the accompanying papers have been lost. It seems that the printer claims he returned them to the Department of the Interior and the Department of the Interior claims they never were received and that this argument has been going on for the last 75 years.

If you want copie made from the printed books it might be better to order from the Library of Congress. It seems that there is some sort of a gentlemen 's agreement between the Archive and the Library of Congress to the effect that the Archives will copy only manuscripts and that printed work will be perroduced at the library. I'm quite sure any order sent in by mail will be taken care of at either place.
