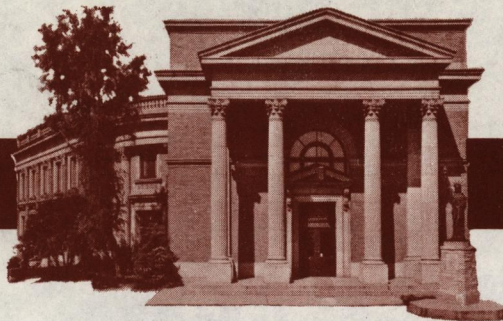

Thanks for your letter. I have been mulling over the many good suggestions you made .


