Have given up the idea of working in Yakima this summer, but may try for it the following year

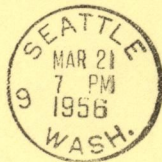
sometime. Will be thru school this June and need to settle down this summer and get myself out of debt and possibly a car before I can hope to trot around the reservation as I hope to do.
