All the world waits! Will they appear to help celebrate the 20th anniversary? June 24, 1967, marks the 20th Anniversary of the famous Kenneth Arnold sighting of nine "Flying Saucers" flying 'in line' around the Cascade peaks at Mt Rainier, Wash.

Space Age groups from all over the northwestern part of the North American continent have asked the President of the United States to dedicate a "WATCH FOR FLYING SAUCERS WEEK" June 21 to June 28, noon to noon, Greenwich Mean Time. Research groups, clubs, committees, all over the United States and in other nations are being asked to cooperate and establish 'watches' and 'watch teams' in their areas during this week, June 21 - 28. Mt Rainier, where it all began, Twenty years ago, is being organized into a 'watch' area with a headquarters for World Wide Watch at Eatonville, west of the mountain. Mountaineers, Rangers, volunteers, radio men, whoever will, is asked to join in the effort, centered on the mountain. Last time, they came along a northsouth line from Mt Baker, along the Cascades. This time, watch teams are being posted along a north-south line from Canada and Alaska to Mt Shasta, in California; east and west for several hundred miles and equidistant points northeast, southeast, northwest and southwest, to establish whether intelligent patterns of flight or behavior patterns exist. World wide groups of volunteers are asked to establish a similar 'key' watch point in their area or country where important sightings of Flying Saucers have occured such as Tremonton, Utah; Levelland and Lubbock, Texas, White Sands, New Mexico and Socorro; Mt Shasta, Calif. or some key geographical feature that is known to all, such as the Great Pyramid at Gizeh; Mt Everest, Mt Kilimanjaro; The Andes, etc. The 'not so elusive' Flying Saucers have performedover every country of the world, over every major city as well as hamelts, villages and towns. Now, thousands of "UFO -Flying Saucer" and Space Age groups exist throughout the world that are observing, recording sightings and beginning to 'feret' out meanings of this gigantic visitation.

Reports are being collected and collated from around the world at headquarters for WORLD WIDE WATCH, Mt Rainier Headquarters, P.O. Box 867, Eatonville, Wash 98328. The information, when complete, will be available to all. News reports of events or outstanding features will be released as they occur. City UFO groups in the northwest in Spokane, Vancouver B.C. Tacoma, Olympia, Portland are joined in an effort to reach every possible group in the United States, Canada and other nations. This interpretate the 'quest' is for intelligent patterns of behavior' of flight characteristics such as 'U Turns', right angle turns, reverse turns, straight lines of flight. A French scientist Dr Aime Michele wrote a book entitled "The Straight Line Mystery, recording how UFO's over Europe were observed flying for hundreds of miles in straight lines.

Special attention is to be devoted to any attempts to communicate, and all such incidents are to be carefully recorded, i.e. signals, radio or tv signals, color or light signals as well as other methods of communication that might occur, or be observed.

Since this effort is volunteer and civilian in nature, first priority of reports should be to groups that are correlating the 'watch', beginning with Mt. Rainier Headquarters, then other groups in any area, country, city etc. Next priority is governmental departments that may be interested or are cooperating, as in the United State Project Blue Book, Wright Patterson Field, Dayton, Ohio; Dr. Edward U. Condon, University of Colorado, Boulder, Colo.; news media, periodicals in all areas, civic and public officials of provinces, states, cities, towns. The President of the United States has been invited to assign a personal observer to World Wide Watch to observe developments. The information that develops, if any, will be available to all groups, countries, etc.

Astronomers, scientists, space research engineers are being invited to serve on National Advisory Boards and International Advisory Boards, both to advise and study results of World Wide Watch.

Events already scheduled for the Twentieth Anniversary period are:

A Caravan of autos and trailers to Headquarters, Mt Rainier Eatonville, Wash. from all points on Saturday, June 24. All interested parties can join in this caravan. After meeting at the Headquarters, Eatonville, they will proceed to various points at or around Mt Rainier for activities to commemorate the 20th Anniversary.

A WORLD WIDE WATCH Convention in the Seattle, Tacoma, Mt Rainier area July 22-23, the exact location to be announced. Reports will be made of the outcome and findings of World Wide Watch at this convention and various speakers will be introduced.

A third event already scheduled on the east coast and in New York City is NEW YORK'S FIRST FLYING SAUCER CONVENTION at Hotel Commodore, June 22 through June 25. Sponsor is James Moseley, editor and publisher of Saucer News, P.O. Box 163, Fort Lee, N.J. 07024. National Headquarters, Suite 1615, 303 Fifth Ave. NY.,N.Y. 10016, Telephone(212) 686 3743 Some of the speakers already scheduled are: Kenneth Arnold from Australia, Gray Barker, Art Ford, Gordon Evans, Long John Nebel, New York City radio personality, Howard Menger, author of "From Outer Space to You", James Moseley, Ray Palmer of Amherst, Wisconsin, James Randi, Stewart Robb and Ivan Sanderson. Attempts will be made to establish a liaison with events at the New York City FIRST Convention and the west coast World Wide Watch Headquarters for flow of information, and sightings.

Other groups are being encouraged to plan Twentieth Anniversary events in their area or country.

Wednesday morning, June 21, 1967, Watch Teams will gather at Eatonville, Washington--World Wide Watch Headquarters, Mt Rainier and various points throughout the world to "Watch The Skies of Earth" on the anniversary of the famous Kenneth Arnold sighting of nine flying objects near Mt Rainier, June 24, 1947. It was at that time that the word "Flying Saucers" was coined and we have been hearing of it ever since. Now, twenty years later, Gallup Poll says five million Americans have seen Flying Saucers. Will they return on or near the anniversary? If they do, this will indicate desire and need for better communication with earth civilization and the need for a department of 'insular affairs' or perhaps'insolar affairs', especially devoted to handle extra terrestrial visitation on governmental level and to observe their needs upon this earth, in this nation, locale, etc.

Let us Watch the Skies, aware too that the earth is in great turmoil and needs help and advice from wiser and more advanced cultures. The UFO visitation goes clear back to the Sanskrit language, earliest known language on earth, and the help has been continuous, though misunderstood by many.

On June 24, at 10:00 a.m., a Caravan Tour will leave the World Wide Match world headquarters in upper Eatonville for a point at Mt Rainier for dedication and ceremony, also to Watch the Skies. Potluck food is to be brought by participants and an Indian style Chautauqua will ensue with singing, music and festivities.

Volunteers who wish to help with 'the Watch' are asked to bring sleeping bags or camping gear and food supplies to Eatonville and all others are encouraged to form Watch Teams wherever they are and keep a watch on the skies. They (the UFO's) could appear anywhere because sightings have been world-wide. The Northwest Council of UFO groups, conducting the World Wide Watch for this area, recommends that cameras be at the ready as well as field glasses, telescopes, etc. and a 'ham radio' alert has been sounded as well as a news alert by all media. The Watch begins at 12:00 noon, June 21, Greenwich Mean Time and ends at 12:00 noon on the 28th of June.
