Our com ittee is just getting under way and later various members will work on specific projects. But, in view of your past associations there, either at the fort or the "ilbur Church, could you contribute to our files by sketching out any infimation you may have.

Could you sketch a rough map of the area, including "hite Swan and Simce, locating: 1-Old churches and their approximate dates, notes about them as you recall, dates of destruction etc.

2-"nything about the old Fiutes, where they were stationed when brought on the Reservation in 1878?

5-Names and addresses of anyone else we may communicate with.
We are assembling interviews with those formerly associated there with either the fort or the Wilbur church; photographs, etc.

We need short stories of "recollections, about pastors, agents, Indian characters etc.

We need biographies of those prominently connected with the agency and church.

We need a listing of artifacts connected with the old days there so we may create a card index of them.

We are also creating a card index of libraries throughout the Northwest and material they have pertaining to Fort Simcoe and Father Wilbur.

All of this will be filed, typed, copies made for a double file and classified so it will be available for researchers, students, and the national park technicians when the actual restoration work begins.

Thanks again for your interest and I do hope you find time to write as completely and fully as possibly, covering various subjects as you think of them. We are giving our time to this worthy project and hope many others will join with us so we may have the most intensive research possible.
