Procedures for coming on campus

When first visiting us, you'll register at the main gate and be given a visitor's pass. Please carry the pass with you at all times while at the Center. Generally, you won't be allowed to drive your car on campus unless it's a special occasion. The gate guard will be informed if this is the case.

We're ladies and we expect to be treated like ladies, so watch your language please.

If you prefer strong drink better visit somewhere else. Drinking anything stronger than coke or coffee is not permitted at the Center.
