Transmitted with this dispatch are original and one copy of notes on the Colville-Palouse.

The overlap with the Yakima is easily understood when the notes are read, and in my opinion, handling in this manner will clarify rather than confuse the situation.

I am titling it Colville-Palouse MS I in the event an encounter pertinent, substantiating material to be appended.

The notes were prepared with a view of compiling miscellaneous material regarding the Palouse I have gathered in past years and combining it with later information. One part is confined specifically to questions noted in Claim No. 222.

Appended are miscellaneous photographs and a few photostats to augment the notes. I do not know of any Palouse material, existing, as extensive. I have in my files and library, but did not because of volume, include notes and citations on the Palouse War.

The enclosed clipping, I happened to encounter, may be of general interest.
