Enclosed is original and first copy of Yakima MS-I, completing the series of background MS that I told you I would send. This will confirm that the preparation of this MS, like the Colville and Umatilla notes, was not an assignment.

I don't know that the Yakima material will be of great assistance, but it at least will give an insight into enrollment procedure, background of individuals and situations, and may provoke some ideas.
