SATUS-Name of creek and Irrigation Project in Yakima County. The creek is a tributary of the Yakima River. Name also for hills. Spelled Sattus, Setas, Sattas. Setaslema was name for people of rye grass prairie . In very early days, Satas Jim, a Coast Indian, lived in that area.

SIM-KWEE-Low gap or saddle in hills, northeast of Fort Simcoe State Park, name for that specific gap ~~which~~ which is location of proposed \$5,500,000 White Swan Irrigation Project Dam, and name for hills, valley, mountain and creek. It was the ~~xx~~ name given to the station at present Wapato by the Northern Pacific. Spelled Sim-co-ee on early ~~correspondence~~ correspondence of Army officers. It is from this word that Simcoe was derived.

SKEIN-Cradle Board, on right bank of Columbia River opposite Selilo Falls, just below railroad bridge west of the falls. Skeinpa~~m~~, locative. Named for the shape of sand flat along river on which was located fishing village. Wah Pykt, meaning water fall, was located just above Skeinpa



SKU KO LAT KA-Village where Moses' people lived at mouth of Moses Coulee.

SLIDE ROAD-See Tahmit Ka Lo Kee

Smoking pot. - 22 Looks - Three miles  
from Wallula on trail leading to Wey River  
Country. It was marked by a large rock.  
A meeting place for migrating tribes ~~to~~  
to talk over matters before going in to the  
river.

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
