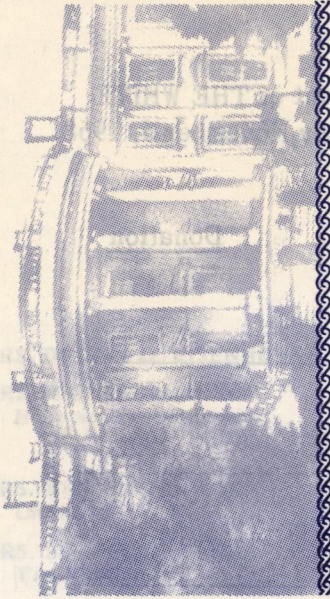

Revised Presidential Lease

AGREEMENT made this 5th day of November, 1968 between THE AMERICAN PEOPLE, party of the first part, hereinafter referred to as the Landlord, and MR. REPUBLICAN PRESIDENT, Party of the second part, hereinafter referred to as the tenant.

WITNESSETH: That landlord hereby leases to TENANT and TENANT hereby hires from LANDLORD, the dwelling known as

THE WHITE HOUSE

located at 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue (together with all the buildings and offices and improvements necessary, for the elected representatives of THE AMERICAN PEOPLE to present the needs of the people, by the people, and for the people. This property located in WASHINGTON, D. C., in the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, for a term of four (4) years, with options for renewal.

The covenants, conditions, and agreements contained in this lease shall bind and inure to the benefit of ALL AMERICAN PEOPLE.

The shortest tax reduction in the history of America

Just before the election in 1966, the Democrats pushed through Congress a bill to repeal certain of the excise taxes.

After the election -- in January -- the President asked Congress to reinstate those taxes.

CONFUSING?

In January, 1967, the President said he wanted a 6% surtax to provide around five billion dollars extra revenue.

Less than six weeks later, the Secretary of the Treasury recommended a two billion dollar tax reduction.

MISLEADING?

At the same time the Secretary confirmed that the Administration planned to repeal the telephone tax and the tax on automobiles effective early in 1968.

Later in August the President sent his recommendation for a 10% tax increase and announced plans to cancel this proposed reduction.

On October 10, 1960, Senator John F. Kennedy said: "Five million Americans go to bed hungry every night on a sub-standard diet."

Now we are told by U. S. Senator Pastore (D. Rhode Island) that we have twenty million Americans living in poverty today.
