Dear Order Librarian:

I am holding Order No. 4593 for 6 (six) copies of "1855-1955 the Yakimas." This was published in 1955 at the occasion of the Treaty Centennial. This book is now out of print and can still, however, be provided.

I think perhaps you wished rather "Strangers on the Land" published Feb. 5, 1963.

The treaty booklet was published at \$1 and was raised when out of print and only a small amount left, two months ago.

Library and dealer discounts are:

1855-1955 the yakimas	1.20 unit price for \$2.00 retail (or library)
Strangers on the Land	1.35 unit price for \$2.25 retail (or library)

The latter contains 63,000 words, normal book length despite its deceptive format. The former about 28,000. Putting either in hard cover would have raised the price \$1.25 to \$2.00 per vol.

I am assisting the publications committee in getting the book "Strangers" on the market and in libraries.

If you will examine the two enclosed, I will be grateful and that way can be sure you are obtaining the desired item. If you wish "Strangers" I will send the five other copies with processed invoice, and you may add the Treaty booklet to your northwest material. I am sure the tribal officials would want you to have it.
