mule, while grazing on the
common near the Dalles, by
striking them with the cars
The horses are or should be worth
at least \$20 each and the mule
\$25 making \$85.00

Inspector Pollock wrote me that
the Co had agreed to pay allowing
\$15 each for the horses and \$25 for
the mule - Rather than have any
controversy the Indians reluctantly
consented to settle on that basis
and I so notified the Company
but they paid no further attention
to the matter - On the basis as agreed
with Inspector Pollock it would be \$70.00
