Papers of the United States Senate relating to affairs in the Territories that were segregated from the main body of Senate records by the Department of State for possible publication in *The Territorial Papers of the United States* (Washington, 1934-) pursuant to an act of Congress approved March 3, 1925, and an amendment thereto of February 28, 1929. Some of these papers have been or will be published in *The Territorial Papers*, which are now edited for publication by the National Archives. Many of them, however, are outside the scope of the published or projected volumes.

These papers were created as a result of the constitutional prerogatives of Congress over Territories, its power to admit new States, its control of appropriations, and the right of the people to petition Congress for a redress of grievances. In the main they consist of petitions and memorials, bills, resolutions, reports from ex-

ecutive departments, and correspondence. The papers are arranged by date of the organic act creating each Territory, then by Congress, and thereafter in rough chronological order. Documents dated earlier or later than the period of the existence of a particular Territory are sometimes included.
