while it is not my concern, I note that various tabs were inserted into the Letter Record Book from which I was making complete or nearly complete typescripts.

The notation "Moses" appeared on pps. 5, 70, 79, 85, 87, 101.

Believing that they may be of general interest to attorneys
in the Department I have selected them from my files.

Also segregated, and attached under corresponding notations such as Snakes, Piutes on Yakima Reservation, Depredations, Abe incoln, Clothing, Offsets, carpenter shop, supplies, schools, government herd at agency, Wenatches Fishery, are other copies.

I point out that such scattering letters are not a true representation of the picture or subject covered as I have found by gathering some 200 pps. of Moses material alone, and hundreds oo ering the other subjects.

I note too that there is reference to Priest Rapids, Smowhala,

cut because if the intention is to exclude the Priest Rapids or Wanapums from occupancy along that area of the river, there is an abundance of contrary evidence, and in fact a person familiar with the geographic area involved will not gain the same idea as one would gain by reading these letters. Morever, rather than closing out the Priest Rapids or Manapums, the letters perhaps would restrict the size of the Yakima claims. However if the idea is to show that Moses could not settle on the Yakima reservation, because of animosity of whites and others, there is much more to be offered on that here; subject. And, my files are available.

Some of the material from the letter record books will more properly fit into the various Manuscripts, Yakima-I, Wanapum-I etc. to fill out the picture, completely, but so that nothing is overlooked from my observation, I am sending copies that have been tabbed for typescript by others searching through the Letter ecord Books.

I am sure that the time they could have spent was small compared to the many hours it has required me to make a nearly complete typescript record of the Letter Record Books. This information fills in xx nearly where the various File Microcopy records leave off. There is one period of xxxxx several years, missing apparently from both Microsopy and Letter Record Books.

Upon request, I shall be most hap y to provide the intervening material represented in the scattering references herein enclosed, remembering that these havebeen tabbed for typescript by someone, evidently connected with pressing claims.
